Ordered that the Clerk of the Executive write to the

to discontinue the subscription in its behalf in their respective
papers.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington
of Duck or Bide eighty three dollars twenty three cents for two months salary
as Announcer at Annapolis due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James
Dee of Duck or Bide one hundred dollars fifty seven cents and a half cents for
compensation and expence for bringing Robert Grimes a fugitive from
Justice from Philadelphia to Baltimore, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jeremiah
Coughy or Bide fifty eight dollars twenty cents and a half cents for
copies of the laws of 1830, \$2 for advertising for proposals for distributing
the laws, \$5 for publishing same relative to divorces and for papers for
a new volume containing said laws, \$25 for printing 300 certificates of
stock issued by the Treasurer, \$1 for publishing notice of meeting of the
Executive, \$10 for subscription to the American Republican from the
22^d of September 1829 to the 22^d of September 1831, \$3.00 for Sunday
articles in the Government Friend, and \$6.12 for Sunday articles in the
Executive Friend amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay
Thomas Fisher or Bide two dollars for printing the Appeal Recd
on the State Record Hill, amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Alexander
Fisher or Bide fifty seven dollars six cents for publishing in his paper by order
of the Executive as follows: viz Proclamation of Benjamin Quakemaster
\$3.00; Proclamation of election of electors of President and Vice President \$3.00;
notice for proposals for delivering the laws \$1.00; Proclamation of
Amos C. Jacobs \$3.50; notice for proposals for executing the public
printing \$1.00 and for Proclamation of the Election of members of Congress
\$3.00 amount allowed.
