

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Elizabeth Miles or order one hundred and twenty eight dollars fifty cents for books for the State Library, purchased by the Joint Committee of the Senate and House of Delegates, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Cushing Jones or their order one hundred and thirty nine dollars eighty three cents for books for the State Library, purchased by the Joint Committee of the Senate and of the House of Delegates, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Edward Cole or order two hundred and fifty eight dollars fifteen cents for books for the State Library, purchased by the Joint Committee of the Senate and of the House of Delegates, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Page, Esquire, or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as a member of the Council, due the first return.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order twenty two dollars twelve cents and a half for stationery for the Executive, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jeremiah Houghy or order forty two dollars, viz \$30 for printing Good Marriage License, \$11 for publishing in his paper and order of Council and three acts of Assembly, and \$1 for publishing notice of the meeting of the Council, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Librarian have bound under and in virtue of the Resolution of 1824 5 parts of the acts of Congress from 1801 to 1830 2 Copies of the public documents, and four Copies of the argument of Williams, Writ Esquire, in the case of the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company against the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company.

Ordered that the Librarian have three Copies of the pamphlet Laws of each the States and Territories of the United, that are now in the Library bound, as provided for by Resolution of the last General Assembly.

Ordered that the Clerk of the Council send to the Executive of the State of Delaware a copy of Kelly, Harris & Watkins's edition of the Laws, and the acts of the several Sessions of the General Assembly asked for by the letter of the Secretary of that State, dated 15th of March 1830, and that he address a letter to the Governor of each State and Territory, and request them, to furnish the Executive of this State with Copies
