The following may use, they are signed by His Excellency the Governor upon the several demands, and the information and returns thereon respectively mentioned viz.

The State of Maryland, From the Sheriff of Frederick, in and for this County in this State, Greeting. Whereas, it appears from authentic documents certified and transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, by His Excellency George Wolf Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, that a certain David Agnew, charged by indictment of the Grand Jury of the County of Adams in the State of Pennsylvania, with the crime of fornication and bastardy, and that the said David Agnew has fled from the State, therein stated, and believed to have taken refuge in this State. And whereas the said George Wolf Governor as aforesaid, hath in pursuance of the authority given in such case by the Constitution and Laws of the aforesaid State, demanded the said David Agnew of the Executive of this State as a fugitive from Justice, and appointed Jacob Landy, Magistrate to receive the said fugitive and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania for trial for the said Offense. — and Now, therefore, Daniel Hartman, Governor of the State of Maryland, have thought proper, in compliance with the said demand to order and direct the Sheriffs of the said County, and do hereby order and direct that you forthwith, arrest and deliver the said David Agnew, if he is to be found within your jurisdiction, to the said Jacob Landy, Magistrate as aforesaid, to the said Magistrate first paying a duty, for the arrest and detention of the said fugitive — for all which you shall be bound sufficient Warrant. Given under my hand and the Great Seal of the State of Maryland this eleventh day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety one, the Independence of the aforesaid State, the 11th day of June.

The Corroborate Act of the said.

The State of Maryland, do hereby in compliance with a demand of His Excellency George Wolf Governor of the State of Pennsylvania that may have been given for the surrender of a certain David Agnew, as a fugitive from the Justice of the said State, to Jacob Landy, Magistrate duly appointed to receive the said fugitive and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania: it appearing from authentic documents transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, that the said David Agnew, charged by indictment of the Grand Jury of the County of Adams in the State of Pennsylvania, with the crime of fornication and bastardy, and that he is believed to have taken refuge in this State. — and Now, therefore, Daniel Hartman, Governor of the State of Maryland, do hereby require and require all persons within this State to let the said Jacob Landy, Magistrate as aforesaid,
