The State of Maryland, to the Sheriff of Baltimore, or of any other County, in this State, Greeting. Whereas it appears from authentic documents, certified and transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, by His Excellency George Wolf Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, that a certain William Heaffer stands charged by Indictment of the grand Jury of the County of Adams in the State of Pennsylvania, with the crime of fornication and bastardy, and that the said William Heaffer has fled from the Justice of the said State, and is believed to have taken refuge in this State. And whereas the said George Wolf Governor, as aforesaid, hath, in pursuance of the authority given in such cases by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, demanded the said William Heaffer of the Executive of this State, as a fugitive from Justice, and appointed Jacob Sanders his agent to receive the said fugitive and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania, for trial for the said offense. In proof thereof I Daniel Martin, Governor of the State of Maryland have thought proper, in compliance with the said demand, to order and direct the Carrier of the said fugitive, and do hereby order and direct that you, forthwith, arrest and deliver the said William Heaffer, if he is to be found within your bailiwick to the said Jacob Sanders agent, as aforesaid, and the said agent first paying all costs of the arrest and detention of the said fugitive for all which this shall be your sufficient warrant.
