using no improper severity or cruelty in his treatment of the said prisoner.

The State of Maryland, To the Sheriff of Washington, or of any other  
County in this State, Greeting. Whereas, it appears from authentic documents,  
certificates and transcripts to the Executive Department of this State by His  
Excellency George Wolf, Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, that a  
certain Lewis Lerew, stands charged by the affidavit of Rhoda Greenwood  
of Adams County in the said State of Pennsylvania, with the crimes of  
fornication and bastardy, alleged to have been committed in the said County  
of Adams and State of Pennsylvania, and that the said Lewis Lerew, has  
fled from the Justice of the said State, and is believed to have taken refuge  
in this State. And whereas the said George Wolf Governor as aforesaid,  
hath in pursuance of the authority given in such cases by the Constitution  
and laws of the United States, demanded the said Lewis Lerew of the  
Executive of this State, as a fugitive from Justice, and appointed Harmon  
Wierman his agent to receive the said fugitive and transport him to the  
said State of Pennsylvania for trial for the said offence. Now therefore,  
I Daniel Martin, Governor of the State of Maryland have thought  
proper in compliance with the said demand to order and direct the surrender  
of the said fugitive, and do hereby order and direct that you forthwith,  
arrest and deliver the said Lewis Lerew, if he is to be found within your  
bailiwick, to the said Harmon Wierman agent as aforesaid; he the said  
agent first paying all costs of the arrest and detention of the said fugitive -  
for all which this shall be your sufficient warrant.
