

Wine and agent, duly appointed to receive the said fugitive and transport him
to the State of Pennsylvania: it appearing from authentic documents transmitted
to the Executive Department of this State, that the said Lewis Crew stands charged
by the affidavit of Rhoda Greenwood of Adams County in the said State of
Pennsylvania with the crime of fornication and battery, alleged to have been
committed in said County of Adams and State of Pennsylvania; and that he
is believed to have taken refuge in this State. — And, therefore, I, James
Martin, Governor of the State of Maryland, do hereby require and desire in all
persons within this State to let the said James Wine and agent as aforesaid
pass with the said fugitive, unmolested to the said State of Pennsylvania; he
the said agent conducting himself in a peaceable and orderly manner, and
using no improper severity or cruelty in his treatment of the said prisoner.

Given under my hand and the Great Seal of the State of
Great Maryland, this eleventh day of June in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and thirty one, and of the Independ-
ence of the United States, the fifty fifth.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Anthony McBride
or order thirty six dollars eight, seven and a half cents for expenses incurred in
taking Edward McBride a deaf and dumb boy, selected by His Excellency
the Governor, to the Pennsylvania Institution to be educated at the expense
of the State, if account allowed.

June 27th 1831.

His Excellency the Governor, this day, granted a Pardon to James
Harris, negro, on account of Stealing to the amount of ten dollars: of which
he was convicted in Baltimore City Court, at June term 1831.

June 29th 1831.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Moses
Sheppard or order seven thousand four hundred and eighty six and
seventy cents, in redemption of seven thousand dollars of his certificate for
seventeen thousand dollars of five percent Tobacco Inspection Stock and
in payment of the interest on thirteen thousand dollars thereof, accrued
on the 10th day of November last, to the 3d of July 1831.
