

The Honble George Howard, first named of the Council appeared in the Council Chamber, and qualified as Governor, by taking the Oath prescribed by the Constitution of this State, and the Constitution of the United States, and by subscribing a declaration of his belief in the Christian Religion, before the Honble Theodorick Bland Chancellor of this State.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Samuel W. Spencer or order eleven dollars fifty cents for publishing acts of the General Assembly, by order of the Executive, for amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Page or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as a member of the Council, due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas C. Worthington or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as a member of the Council, due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Matthew Jackson or order sixty and dollars thirty seven cents for compensation and expenses as agent to Delaware for a fugitive from Justice, for amount allowed.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, and by and with the advice and consent of the Council the following Civil appointments were made, and commissions issued accordingly Viz.

Caleb Davis & David Lamborn, additional Justices of the Peace, of the third Annapolis County.

Thomas Hillen Esquire, Director of the Penitentiary, vice Nathaniel F. Williams, resigned.

Doctor William S. M. Pherson, of Frederick County, a Commissioner to attend the limits of Circuit Taxation, within the City of Baltimore, vice John B. Howard, Esquire, declined.

Isiah Bayly, Esquire, of Dorchester County, Attorney General, vice Roger B. Taney, appointed Attorney General of the United States, and resigned.

Willis Charles, one of the Justices of the Levy Court of Caroline County, vice Douglas deceased.

Alfred W. Thompson, Justice of the Peace for Baltimore, residing in the City of Baltimore, vice help commissioned by the Council Alfred Thompson.
