Whereas, it has been represented by the petition of sundry
respectable Citizens of the upper part of Anne Arundel County, that
for several years past there has been a great deal of mischief done in
their neighbourhood in breaking open Tobacco Houses, Stealing of Tobacco,
and burning of Houses and other property; and that in the month of Decem-
ber last Ignatius Wathen's Tobacco House was set on fire, and with its con-
sisting of all his Tobacco, Flour, Corn and Corn fodder burnt down and
consumed, and that in April last Edward Warfield's Tobacco House was
also set on fire, and with his whole crop of Tobacco therein burnt down
and consumed; that the petitioners are much alarmed by the frequent
repetition of these incendiary depredations, upon the property of their nei-
ghbourhood, and therefore pray the aid of the Executive in discovering and
bringing the perpetrators thereof to Justice. in witness whereof
George Howard, Governor of the State of Maryland, has hereunto
