

The State of Maryland, ^{is the Sheriff of Frederick County, to wit:}
Whereas, it appears from authentic documents, certified and transmitted to the
Executive Department of this State, by His Excellency George Wolf, Governor of the
State of Pennsylvania, that a certain Jacob Eisman stands charged by affidavit
of Susan Furman made before John Sulabough a Justice of the Peace of the said
State of Pennsylvania, in and for the County of Adams, with the crime of fornication
and bastardy, committed with the said Susan Furman, in the County and State
aforesaid, and that the said Jacob Eisman has fled from the Justice of the
said State, and now resides (as it is believed) in the said County, in this State.
And whereas the said George Wolf Governor aforesaid, hath, in pursuance
of the authority given in such case, by the Constitution and Laws of the United
States, demanded the said Jacob Eisman of the Executive of this State, as a
fugitive from Justice, and appointed Jacob Sandus his agent to receive the said
fugitive and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania for trial for the
said offence. Now, therefore, George Howard, Governor of the State of
Maryland have thought proper, in compliance with the said demand, to
order and direct the surrender of the said fugitive, and I do hereby, order and
direct that you forthwith, arrest and deliver the said Jacob Eisman, if he
is to be found in your bailiwick, to the said Jacob Sandus, agent aforesaid;
be the said agent first paying all the costs of the arrest and detention of the
said fugitive. — for all which this shall be your sufficient warrant.

The State of Maryland to wit: Whereas, in compliance with a
demand of His Excellency George Wolf Governor of the State of Pennsylvania
orders have been given for the surrender of a certain Jacob Eisman, as
a fugitive from the Justice of the said State, to Jacob Sandus agent,
and appointed to receive the said fugitive and transport him to the said
State of Pennsylvania: it appearing from authentic documents, certified and
transmitted to the Executive Department of this State that the said Jacob
Eisman stands charged by affidavit of Susan Furman made before
John Sulabough, a Justice of the Peace of the said State of Pennsylvania
in and for the County of Adams, with the crime of fornication and bastardy
committed with the said Susan Furman in the County and State
aforesaid. Now, therefore, George Howard Governor of the State of Maryland,
hereby require and enjoin all persons within this State, to let the said Jacob
Sandus agent as aforesaid, pass with the said fugitive unmolested to the
said State of Pennsylvania: be the said agent conducting himself in
peaceable and orderly manner and using no improper violence
in his treatment of the said prisoner. — Given under my hand
