

July 27 1831.
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order, nine hundred and seventy dollars for delivering the Laws and notes and proceedings of the last General Assembly to the Clerks of the several Counties of this State, & Contract.

July 30th 1831.
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Mary Rumsey Rumsey of Hy Co. order seventeen dollars fifty cents for one quarter Interest due the first Instant upon a certificate of stock for \$1400 held by her or amount of the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouse and City.

August 1st 1831.
His Excellency the Governor, having received notice agreeably to Law from the President and Directors of the Frederick and Harper's Ferry Turnpike Road Company, that they have perfected five continuous miles of the said Road - nominated and appointed, Caspar W. Weaver, John L. Learning and Christian Kemp, to view and examine the same, and report to him in writing the result of their examination, as prescribed by the act of incorporation of the said Company - and commission issued accordingly. (See Turnpike Road book)

His Excellency the Governor, this day, granted a Pardon to a certain Margaret H. Garden, on account of Felony: for which she was convicted in Baltimore City Court, at June Term 1831. (See Pardon Record).

August 5th 1831.
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Shoppard or order six thousand and thirty dollars, in redemption of six thousand dollars balance of his certificate for seventeen thousand dollars of five per cent Tobacco Inspection Stock, and in payment of the Interest thereon to the 7th Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Fletcher or order nine hundred dollars for three Swords to present to Naval Officers in compliance with Resolutions of the General Assembly. - Contract.

August 23rd 1831.
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Edward Martin, one of the Executors of Charles Martin, late Governor, twenty eight dollars eighty six cents, being the balance due for one quarter salary up to the 31st Instant, after deducting an unexpended balance in his hand of six hundred and thirty seven dollars eighty cents appropriated by Resolution No 3 of December
