Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay David Ridgely or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as Librarian, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Benj. Thompson or order one hundred and twenty dollar fifty cents for one quarter salary as messenger of the Council, and keeper of the State House, due in day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Benj. Wells or order sixty two dollar fifty cents for one quarter salary as messenger to the Governor, due this day.
