

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George G. Brewer or order seventy five dollars for one quarter's salary as Clerk of the Board of Delegates, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Elizabeth Neazy or order eighteen dollars & fifty five cents for one quarter's interest, due this day, upon a certificate of stock for fifteen hundred dollars held by her on account of the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouses and Lots.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Doctor William Lappington or order seventeen dollars & fifty cents for one quarter's interest, due this day, upon a certificate of stock for fourteen hundred dollars held by her on account of the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouses and Lots.

October 3^d 1831.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Brown (of New) or order one hundred and sixty dollars & sixty six cents, balance due him for one quarter's salary, up to the 3^d instant, as Examiner General, after deducting the amount of fees received, if amount proved.

October 4th 1831.

A meeting of the Council having been called to be held this day, the Honorable Thomas E. Worthington, attended.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George W. Thomas or order of Hannah M. Wethered or order eighty dollars for six months interest upon a certificate of stock for \$3200 held by him on account of the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouses and Lots, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Page or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter's salary, due the first instant, as a member of the Council.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas E. Worthington or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter's salary as a member of the Council, due this day.

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Writ of Prosequi to John Cole, on account of a charge of selling a quart of Whiskey to a certain Negro for the property of Basil Crabster, which was pending against him in Anne Arundel County Court.
