

October 3rd 1831.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Perry or order thirty one dollars twenty five cents for one quarter Interest, due the first Instant upon a certificate of stock for \$2500, held by him on account of the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouse and Lot.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Mrs Ann Leback or order forty dollars for one quarter pension, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Mrs Rebecca Forrester or order one hundred and eighty dollars for six months pension due the first Instant.

October 6th 1831.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Green or order sixty one dollars ninety cents for his amount for one quarter postage up to the 3rd Instant viz \$56.33 for the Executive and \$5.63 for the Recorder, for amount allowed.

October 17th 1831.

His Excellency the Governor, this day granted a Volle Prosequi to Francis S. Key, on account of Papalists & Battering, committed on the bodies of Richard Knighton and Richard Hollyday, which were charged against him in Anne Arundel County Court. (See Pardon Book)

October 20th 1831.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Mary Reimsy (of H. C.) or order seventeen dollars and fifty cents for one quarter Interest, due the first Instant, on \$1400 of Abaco Inspection Stocks.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John Bacon Treasurer of the Pennsylvania Institution for the Deaf and Dumb or his order, one thousand three hundred and sixty dollars for six months support, tuition &c of seventeen pupils in the said institution.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Richard Adams or order one hundred and twenty dollars for six months pension due the first Instant.

October 25th 1831.

His Excellency the Governor attended this day in the Council Chamber, and granted a Pardon to Mary Thompson, on account of a charge of Stealing one Silver Spoon and one Silver cup of the Value of twelve dollars, which was pending against her in Baltimore City Court (See Pardon Book)

His Excellency also this day granted a Volle Prosequi to John Alexander, on account of a charge of having committed two Battering and Battering on the body of James Dumas, and an assault & battery on the body of John Cowan, which were pending against him in ...
