His Excellency the Governor this day granted a full Pardon to Walter B. Brooke, on account of a assault & Battery, pending against him in Prince Georges County Court, (see parson Record)

His Excellency the Governor, this day presented to Captain David Geisinger, Lieutenant Joseph Sauer, and to John Foster Esquire, each, a plated Sword, as a testimony of the approbation of their Native State of their Gallantry and good Conduct in the several Engagements with the Enemy, in which they respectively participated, during the late War with Great Britain, in compliance with Resolutions of the General Assembly.

The following Order was issued by His Excellency the Governor, upon the demand and information and evidence therein contained viz

No. 100. Maryland, to the Warden of the Jail of Baltimore County, greeting: Whereas it appears from authentic documents, certified and transmitted to the Executive Department of this State by His Excellency George Wolf Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, that a certain Simon Eicholtz late of the City of Lancaster in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, stands charged by indictment of the Grand Jury of the City and County of Lancaster with having committed the crime of Manslaughter in the said County; and the said Simon Eicholtz has fled from the Justice of the said State, and is now confined in the Jail of the City of Baltimore in this State.

And whereas the said George Wolf Governor as aforesaid hath, in pursuance of the authority given in such cases by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, demanded the said Simon Eicholtz, of the Executive
