Ordered that the Adjutant General draw upon the National Government for one hundred Rifles of the latest invention, to be deposited in the Barracks in Frederick, subject to the future order of the Executive

Ordered that the Adjutant General apply to the proper officer of the general Government for an advance of \$300 Horseman's Swords, 300 Horseman's Pistols & accoutrements, 200 Artillery Swords and 600 Rifle accoutrements, on account of the States quota of arms under the act of Congress providing for arming the whole body of the Militia.

Ordered that the Armorer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Alexander Somerville sixty Rifles and accoutrements, upon his filing his Bond for the safe keeping and return of said arms when called for.

Ordered that the Armorer at Frederick deliver to Captain thirty eight muskets and accoutrements.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or his heirs thirty six dollars seventy five cents viz \$34.39 for compensation and expenses for bringing John Corn a fugitive from Justice from the District of Columbia to the City of Baltimore and \$2.37 for Stationary for the Executive, pursuant allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G. Puck or his heirs one hundred and twenty dollars seventy five cents for expenses in sending away arms and ammunition to different parts of the State, for amount allowed.
