Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay His Excellency George  
Howard or order six hundred and sixty six dollars sixty six cents, for one quarter salary  
as Governor, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Culbreth  
or order three hundred and seventy five dollars for one quarter salary as Clerk  
of the Council, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Potter  
or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as a  
member of the Council, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Samuel  
Turner or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary  
as a member of the Council, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington  
Clyde or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter  
salary as a member, at Annapolis, due this day.

Monday January 2d 1832.

This being the day prescribed by the Constitution for the Election  
of Governor, His Excellency George Howard, was, on the joint  
ballot of both branches of the Legislature, elected to that Office for the  
ensuing year.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay J. C.  
Thompson or order one hundred and twelve dollars fifty cents, for one  
quarter salary as impinger of the Council, and for taking care of the State  
House, due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William  
Cridgely or order one hundred and twenty five dollars, for one quarter  
salary as Librarian, due the first Instant.
