

Tuesday January 3rd 1832.

This being the day prescribed by the Constitution for the election of a Council to the Governor, William Cotton of Caroline County, Thomas Worthington, of Frederick County, Samuel Turner, of Culbert County, George W. Furnell, of Worcester County, and Robert McBowen, of Prince Georges County, were on the joint ballot of both branches of the Legislature, duly elected a Council to the Governor, for the ensuing year.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Louis Gaspaway or order thirty seven dollars fifty cents, for one quarter salary of Clerk of the Senate, due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Doctor William Cappington, or order seventeen dollars fifty cents, for one quarter interest due the first Instant, upon a certificate of Stock for \$1400, held by him, in account of the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouses and Lots.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Percy or order thirty one dollar twenty five cents, for one quarter interest due the first Instant, upon a certificate of stock for \$2500, held by him, in account of the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouses and Lots.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Brown of Benz, or order one hundred and fifty nine dollars thirty seven cents, for balance of quarter salary as Examiner General, due the first Instant, after deducting account of fees received, & account proved.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Richard Wally, or order sixty two dollars fifty cents, for one quarter salary due the first Instant, as Steward to the Governor.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Susannah Neazy or order eighteen dollars seventy five cents, for one quarter interest due the first Instant, upon a certificate of stock for \$1500, held by her, in account of the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouses and Lots.

January 7th 1832.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Worthington or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as a member of the Council, due the first Instant.
