By the petition of Samuel Hillard, and a transcript from
the Records of Montgomery County Court, it appears that, at a November term
of the said Court, in the year 1850, he entered into a recognizance, together
with Arthur McClaskey, in the sum of one hundred dollars each, for
the appearance of the said McClaskey, before the said Court, to answer a
prement against him for an assault & battery, on William Collins,
and that the said recognizance has since been forfeited.

The Petitioner states that the said McClaskey and Collins
went to Canada and left the State before the next term
of the Court, and that the said McClaskey failed to attend the Court
agreeably to the said recognizance. He further states, that there were
several persons present at the time the assault & battery was alleged to
have been committed, and that all of them, being examined by a
Magistrate, at the petitioner's request, stated upon oath that the
assault was committed by the said William Collins, that he is poor and
unable to pay said forfeiture, upon which execution has been issued, and
for which he is in custody of the Sheriff. He, therefore, prays for remission
of the said forfeiture. And the Honble Charles J. Kellogg, one of the
Judges of the said Court, having recommended a compliance with the
prayer of the petitioner, we do, hereby, remit the said forfeiture.
