Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Anna Green or order one hundred and sixteen dollars for postage for one quarter up to the first Instant, viz for the Executive \$115.96, for the Treasurer \$8.20, for the Adjutant General \$1.84, & amount approved and allowed.

The Council met P.M. 2 P.M. the same as yesterday.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas C. Worthington or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as a member of the Council due the first Instant.
