

May 7th 1832

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Elizabeth Ann or order thirteen dollars fifty cents, for six months Salary for cleaning the Public Temple, due the first Instant.

May 9th 1832

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay P. M. Nickles P. J. Johnson or order four hundred and nine dollars fifty five cents, for books for the State Library, purchased by order of the Joint Committee on the Library, under Resolution of the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Littleton D. Finkle or order for J. J. Hitchcock, six hundred and two dollars twenty two cents, for books for the State Library, purchased by order of the Joint Committee on the Library, under Resolution of the General Assembly.

May 15th 1832.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Ogden Niles or order thirty three dollars, for publishing in the Frederick Herald, the License Law and the Laws relating to free people of color, and to free negroes and Slaves, as provided for by Resolution of the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John B. Spencer or order thirty three dollars, for publishing in the Centerville Times, the License Law and the Laws relating to free people of color, and to free negroes and Slaves, as provided for by Resolution of the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Samuel W. Spencer or order thirty three dollars, for publishing in the Kent Inquirer, the License Law, and the Laws relating to free people of color, and to free negroes and Slaves, as provided for by Resolution of the General Assembly.

May 19th 1832

His Excellency the Governor this day appointed Parson T. Abraham Manuel, free negro, on account of Stealing of which he had been convicted in Worcester County Court at May Term Instant, and for which was sentenced to the Penitentiary for two years. (See Parson Record.)

May 25 1832.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Miles or order forty five dollars, for (nine months) Rent of a Magazine, due 3rd Instant.
