

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George Howard or order, six hundred and sixty six dollars sixty six cents, for a quarter salary as Governor, due this day. ~

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay David Ridgely or order two hundred dollars, for one quarter salary as Librarian, due this day. ~

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order one hundred and twelve dollars fifty cents for one quarter salary as messenger of the Council, and for taking care of the State House &c, due this day. ~

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Potter or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as a member of the Council, due this day. ~

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Richard Wells or order sixty two dollars fifty cents, for one quarter salary as Steward to the Governor, due this day. ~

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Joseph H. Nicholson or order thirty seven dollars fifty cents, for one quarter salary as Clerk of the Senate, due this day. ~

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Robert W. Bowie or order one hundred and twenty five dollars, for one quarter salary as a member of the Council, due the first instant. ~

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Mills or order fifty two dollars, for one quarter Rent of Magazine, due the 3rd of August last. ~

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Brown of Put, or order one hundred and fifty three dollars sixty nine cents for balance of quarter salary as Examined General, due the first instant, after deducting the amount of fees received & amount proved. ~
