And where information has been received, at the Executive
Department of this State, that there is a Mr. Warner, a fugitive from Justice,
and is now detained in the Jail of Bedford County, in Pennsylvania.
And it being important, and highly necessary, for the good of society, that
the perpetrators of such offences should be brought to justice. Now, therefore
I James Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland, by virtue of the
authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of the United States,
do hereby demand the said Mr. Warner, as a fugitive from the Justice
of this State, and make known to your Excellency that I have appointed
Henry Thompson Esquire, the speaker of the Executive Council of this State,
my agent to receive the said fugitive and bring him to this State, having
Jurisdiction of the said offence that he may be brought to trial therefor.

In compliance with the requisitions of the Law, I herewith
annex and produce to your Excellency a copy of the Representation upon
which this Demand is founded; which I certify is authentic.

The following commission and instruction was issued to the
aforesaid agent viz.

The State of Maryland To Henry Thompson Esquire, Speaker
of the Executive Council, Greeting. Be it known that reposing great
trust and confidence in your prudence and honesty, I James Thomas
Governor of the State of Maryland, have appointed you my agent to
receive from His Excellency the Governor of the State of Pennsylvania
a certain Mr. Warner a fugitive from the Justice of this State, and
do hereby authorize and direct you, upon receiving the said fugitive
to bring him into this State, and commit and deliver him to the Sheriff
of Frederick County, to answer for passing two counterfeit ten dollar
notes, knowing them to be counterfeit, and importing them to be genuine
on the Western Bank, one to Michael Rizer and one to Barney
Bigham, where with he stands charged by Representation of the
Legislature of the State of Maryland for the body of Frederick County.
