

Friday October 4th 1833.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay for
James or John or William or Jonathan being three cents, for his account
in the State for the year ending the 31st. instant viz for the Treasurer
\$1.19 for the Treasurer \$1.17 for the Treasurer \$1.16, and for the Treasurer
General \$1.15 and for the Treasurer \$1.14.

Saturday October 5th 1833.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay
William Curben or Peter Liberty five dollars for one quarter
salary as a member of the Council due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay
James or William or Peter Liberty one hundred and twenty five
dollars for one quarter salary as a member of the Council due the
first instant.

Sunday October 7th 1833.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay
William Newman or Peter Liberty one dollar for one quarter
salary as a member of the Council due the first instant.

Friday October 11th 1833.

Returning the Election held on the seventh instant
for Sheriffs of said County having been received by which
it appears that Francis A. Lewis had the greatest number
of legal votes and was declared duly elected first named in
said Return as Sheriff of the said County in Commission
on the day issued to said Francis Lewis as Sheriff as
aforesaid.

Tuesday October 15th 1833.

Returning the Election held on the seventh instant
for Sheriffs of said County and Prince George's County having
been received and it appearing by the return from Charles
County that John W. Baldwin was declared duly elected and
first named in said Return and that he had the greatest
number of legal votes as Sheriff of the said County and it
appearing by the return from Prince George's County that
Thomas Baldwin was declared duly elected and first named
in said return and that he had the greatest number of legal
votes as Sheriff of the said County in Commission on the
day issued to the said John W. Baldwin as Sheriff of Charles
County and to the said Thomas Baldwin as Sheriff of
Prince George's County.
