Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John R. Murphy or order one thousand five hundred dollars, on account of the re-building and repair of Tobacco Warehouse, to be accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Newman or order one hundred and fifty dollars, for repair of the Crumming at Easton, to be accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John S. Martin or order two hundred and fifty dollars, for six months salary as a member of the Council, due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Hammond or order three dollars for freight on Arms & from Snow Hill to Baltimore, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Edward Rock or order twenty dollars for collecting and packing twenty five Stans of Arms and accoutrements, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Durbin or order twenty dollars for the transportation of Arms from the United States Arsenal to Frederick, & amount allowed.
