Resolved that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jeremiah S. Day in order for one hundred dollars, on account of covering the Court House.

Resolved that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jeremiah S. Day in order for one hundred and fifty dollars on account of covering the Court House.

His Excellency the Governor, this day granted a Writ of Habeas Corpus in favor of David on account of a charge of having committed and spent money on William Bryan, pending in Anne Arundel County Court. (See Parol Record)

Sunday October 27th 1833

Returns of the Election held on the seventh Instant for Sheriff of Frederick County, having been received, by which it appears that Charles Ellett had the greatest number of legal votes, and was duly elected, and first named in the said returns, as Sheriff of the said County, a Commission was this day issued to him as Sheriff as aforesaid.

Thursday October 31st 1833

Resolved that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Cutler in order for one hundred and fifty dollars on account of cleaning Army St.

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Writ of Habeas Corpus in favor of Henry Cannon, on account of a charge of having committed and spent money on the body of William McKiern, pending against him in Anne Arundel County Court. (See Parol Record)

Friday November 1st 1833

Returns having been received of the Election held on the seventh Instant for Sheriff of Anne Arundel County, by which it appears that Robert Webb had the greatest number of legal votes, and was duly elected, and first named in the said returns as Sheriff of the said County, a Commission was this day issued to the said Robert Webb, as Sheriff as aforesaid.

Monday November 5th 1833

Resolved that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Elizabeth Sumner or order one dollar and fifty cents for one quarter salary for cleaning the said Court House the first instant.
