

from the service of his said Master, and is now confined in prison in  
the City of Philadelphia. And it being important and highly necessary  
to the good of the said State, that the perpetrators of such offences should be  
brought to Justice. Now, therefore, James Thomas Governor of the  
State of Maryland, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution  
and Laws of the United States, do hereby demand the said Archibald  
Carry, Slave as aforesaid, as a fugitive from the Justice of this State, and  
from the service of his said Master, and make known to your Excellency  
that I have appointed Emeon Cays, one of the Justices of the said  
City of Baltimore, my agent to receive the said fugitive and bring  
him to this State, having Jurisdiction of the said offence, that he may  
be brought to trial therefor, and restored to the service of his said  
Master. In compliance with the requisitions of the Law, I  
herewith annex and produce to your Excellency a Copy of the  
Deposition upon which this Demand is founded, which I certify  
is authentic.

The following commission and instruction was issued to the  
aforesaid agent. Viz

The State of Maryland, To Simon Cays, Gentleman  
Constable of the City of Baltimore, greeting. Be it known that  
reposing great trust and confidence in your prudence and honesty  
James Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland, has appointed  
you my agent to receive from his Excellency the Governor of the  
State of Pennsylvania, Archibald Carry Slave of Susan  
Woolfolk a fugitive from the Justice of this State, and from the  
service of his said Master, and do hereby authorize and direct  
you upon receiving the said fugitive to bring him into this State  
and convey and deliver him to the Warden of the Jail of Baltimore  
County to answer for having stolen and carried away one black  
Cloak of the value of about five dollars, and a Saddle and  
Bridle belonging to the said Horace Knight, and with having  
escaped from the service of his Master the said Susan Woolfolk.
