dollars advanced for that purpose of amount examined and approved.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry
Couten of Island Sullivan or order eighty four dollars eighty seven and
a half cents for balance due them for cleaning Arms, after deducting one
hundred and fifty dollars advanced on that account, of amount proved
and allowed.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis and Stone
Armourer at Frederick two hundred muskets and two hundred Rifles.
