the said marriage a License was obtained, and being somewhat alarmed by some
further information on the subject he proceeded to celebrate the rights of marriage
a second time between the said parties; that the State has lost nothing on the
case, and that there was no design or intention to defraud the State of its just
due, wherefore he prays for a remission of the said fine. And the said
Court, having recommended a compliance with the said prayer, we
do hereby remit the same.
