

Monday January 6th 1834

The message to the House of Delegates prepared on Saturday last was
by the Clerk of the Council to that House?

This being the day prescribed by the Constitution for the Election of Governor
His Excellency James Thomas, of Saint Louis County, was on Joint Ballot of
both branches of the General Assembly, re-elected to that office.

Tuesday January 7th 1834

This being the day prescribed by the Constitution for the Election of
a Council to the Governor, James M. Chapman Esquire, of the City of Baltimore,
George C. Washington Esquire, of Montgomery County, John S. Martin Esquire,
of Worcester County, Thomas W. Nease Esquire, of Cecil County, and Robert W.
Bowie Esquire, of Prince Georges County, were on Joint Ballot of both branches
of the General Assembly, elected to that office.

Wednesday January 8th 1834

His Excellency James Thomas, Governor-re-elect, attended in
the Council Chamber, and at the request of both branches of the General
Assembly, communicated by a joint committee, repaired to the Senate Chamber
and in the presence of both Houses, qualified as Governor, by taking the oath
prescribed by the Constitution and Laws of the State, and by repeating, and
subscribing a declaration of his belief in the Christian Religion.

Thursday January 9th 1834

His Excellency the Governor attended in the Council Chamber

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John
Green or Order Liberty one dollar, eighty two cents, for one quarter year
due the first Instant viz for the Executive \$53:48, for the Treasurer
\$13:89, for the Librarian \$2:76, and for the adjutant General \$1:09,
amount paid.

Friday January 10th 1834

His Excellency the Governor attended in the Council Chamber

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay
J. Cole or Order one hundred and ten dollars, forty nine
cents for the State Library under Resolution of the General Assembly
of certificate of the Librarian.

Saturday January 11th 1834

His Excellency the Governor attended in the Council Chamber
