Gentlemen of the House of Delegates:

In compliance with your order of this day, requesting me to report to you "the number of Agents or representatives, accompanied with their names, that have been appointed to represent the interest of this State in the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company, the compensation that has been allowed to such agents or representatives, and the Vouchers upon which such compensation has been allowed," I have the honor to state, that in virtue of the act of December Session 1829 Chapter 312, the following Gentlemen were appointed on the several days specified to represent the State of Maryland at all future meetings of the Stockholders of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company."

And in virtue of the act of December Session 1832 Chapter 318, on the 9th day of May last, Benjamin F. Forrest Esquire of Montgomery County, James W. McCallah Esquire of Baltimore County, and Charles Goldsborough Esquire of Dorchester County, were appointed to represent the State of Maryland at all future meetings of the Stockholders of any and all joint Stock Companies, which had been or might hereafter be incorporated to make Roads or Canals!

No compensation appears by the Records of this Department to have been allowed to any of the aforesaid Representatives by the Governor and Council, nor does it appear that any claim has ever been presented by them or any of them, to the Executive, for services rendered or expenses incurred in virtue of said appointments, or any of them.
