The following Order was signed by His Excellency the Governor, upon the Demand, and information and evidence therein mentioned.

The State of Maryland, To the Sheriff of Washington County, greeting: Whereas it appears from authentic Documents, certified and transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, by His Excellency George Wolf Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, that a certain John Wilson, late of Franklin County in the said State of Pennsylvania, stands charged on oath with having committed the crime of fornication and bastardy in the said County of Franklin, and that the said John Wilson has fled from the Justice of the said State, and is now in Washington County in this State. And whereas the said George Wolf Governor as aforesaid, hath, in pursuance of the authority given in such cases, by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, demanded the said John Wilson of the Executive of this State, as a fugitive from Justice, and appointed Emmon Elliott Esquire, Sheriff of the said County of Franklin his agent to receive the said fugitive and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania for trial for the said offence. Now therefore, I James Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland have thought proper, in compliance with the said Demand, to order and direct the surrender of the said fugitive; and do hereby Order and direct that you forthwith arrest and deliver the said John Wilson, if he is to be found within your bailiwick, to the said Emmon Elliott Esquire, agent as aforesaid, he the said agent first paying all costs of the arrest and detention of the said fugitive - for all which this shall be your sufficient Warrant.
