Saturday February 8th 1834
The Council met Present, the same as on yesterday.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, and by and with the advice and consent of the Council the following Civil appointments were made, and Commissions issued accordingly, Viz.

Benjamin S. Forrest Esquire, of Montgomery County, James M. McCulloch Esquire, of Baltimore County and Charles Goldborough Esquire, of Dorchester Representatives in all future meetings of the Stockholders of any and all joint stock companies, which have been or may hereafter be incorporated, to make Roads and Canals, in which the State is or may become interested.

Leonard Frailey, Frederick S. Lettig, William Pennington, William Gist, William S. Parker, Thomas H. Belt and James Emsor Gaugus of Cash, and Inspectors of domestic distilled spirits for the City of Baltimore.

William J. Michael, one of the Inspectors of Sole Leather and rough Sames, or Parting Leather, or any other rough Leather, in the City of Baltimore.

His Excellency the Governor nominated Leonard Hernan as the other Inspector of Sole Leather &c. provided for by Law, and on the question will the Council advise and consent to the appointment of the said Hernan determined in the negative.

His Excellency the Governor appointed Francis Skinner of the City of Baltimore, one of his Aids, & a Commission issued to him accordingly.
