In Council, Annapolis, Feb 10 1834

Gentlemen of the Senate  
& the House of Delegates:

We lay before you a communication  
from His Excellency Wilson Lumpkin, Governor of the State of  
Georgia, with Resolutions of the General Assembly of that State, on the  
subject of the Public Lands of the United States; and also a communication  
from His Excellency D. L. Swain, Governor of the State of North  
Carolina, with Resolutions of the General Assembly of that State,  
relative to the Militia, and the public defence.

With the highest consideration  
the Hon. Council
