

Wednesday February 12th 1834.

The Council met Pursuant the same as yesterday.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order one hundred and forty four dollars eighteen cents for balance of his account for firewood, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Armorer at Annapolis purchase one hundred pounds of powder for the purpose of firing Salutes.

Ordered that the Armorer at Annapolis have a piece of six pound Iron Cannon brought from the Armory at Easton and, (if necessary) put in proper repair and, with the usual accoutrements, transported to the Armory at Frederick to be delivered to Henry Horn and allows of Southam, of the Town of Cumberland, or their order.

Ordered that the Armorer at Annapolis have transported to the Armory at Frederick one hundred Rifle, complete.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Spencer and Gunn or order two Dollars for publishing in the Kent's Enquirer an Order of the Adjutant General to the Militia Officers, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Richard Thompson or order eighteen dollars twelve cents for painting and glazing for the State House, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Joseph Wagsaw or order two dollars for trimming Poplar trees on the State House Hill, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Samuel Glicer or order twenty four dollars twenty two cents for scouring, re-hanging and repairing window blinds in the Council Chamber, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William C. Bell or order fifty four dollars, viz \$49 for publishing in the South Light Army Law, \$2 for publishing notice of the Adjutant General to the Militia Officers, and \$3 for publishing Proclamation of Congressional Election, of amount allowed.
