

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to or to his order or order sixteen dollars for five volumes of the Weekly Register bound, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John N. Whittington or order one hundred and twenty seven dollars fifty cents \$127.50 for binding, Books for the Library of Resolution of the General Assembly, \$87.50 for binding Laws, and Journals of the Legislature, and \$15 for a large Record for the Executive, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Samuel C. Veirs administrator of John Porter deceased or order five dollars for the Rockville Free Press for two years, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jesse Reid or order five dollars for publishing two Proclamations in the Hagerstown Free Press in the year 1832, of amount allowed.

Thursday February 13th 1834  
The Council met Present the same as on yesterday.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Alexander and Doctor Julius J. Ducate or to their order two thousand five hundred dollars in compensation for their services under Resolutions of the last General Assembly, no. 48 of 61, relative to a "State Map" and a "Geological Survey."

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John D. H. or order one dollar and fifty cents, for publishing notice of the adjutant general to Militia Offices, of amount allowed.

Friday February 14th 1834  
The Council met Present the same as on yesterday.
