The Council met & read the Minutes yesterday.

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Pardon  
to John S. Swanton on account of a assault with intent to  
kill which he had been convicted in Circuit Court at  
Annapolis Term 1832, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary  
for six years. (See Pardon Record.)

His Excellency also this day granted a Pardon to  
Jacob Wagner on account of "stealing" of which he was convicted  
in Baltimore City Court at February Term Instant.  
(See Pardon Record.)

The respective Comrs. Richard H. Hall, William  
Reverend and John B. Maguire Inspectors of Tobacco, at the  
State Warehouse, in the City of Baltimore and of Samuel  
Stump Inspector General of Flour, and of David Beck's and  
Jacob Dean assistant Inspectors of Flour and of Edward Hughes  
a Lottery Commissioner were laid before the Board and examined
