The following Army were ordered by His Excellency the Governor,  
upon the Demand and information and evidence therein mentioned viz

The State of Maryland, To the Warden of the Jail of Baltimore  
County, Greeting: Whereas, it appears from authentic Documents,  
certified and transmitted to the Executive Department of this State,  
by His Excellency John Floyd Governor of the State of Virginia  
that a certain Noble Peas has changed in the Circuit Superior  
Court of Law for Henrico County in the said State of Virginia, with  
Felony, and that he broke from the Jail of the said County, on the  
night of the eighteenth day of January last, and fled from the Justice  
of the said State, and has been apprehended in the City of Baltimore  
and is now in your custody, by the name of John White alias John  
Peas. And whereas the said John Floyd, Governor as aforesaid,  
hath in pursuance of the authority given in such cases by the Constitution  
and Laws of the United States, demanded the said Noble Peas  
the Executive of this State, as a fugitive from Justice, and appointed  
Francis Hollingshead his agent to receive the said fugitive and  
transport him to the said State of Virginia for trial for the said  
offence. Now, therefore, I James Thomas Governor of the  
State of Maryland have thought proper in compliance with the  
said Demand, to order and direct the Surrender of the said fugitive  
and I do hereby order and direct that you forthwith, deliver  
the said Noble Peas, if he is in your custody, to the said  
Hollingshead agent as aforesaid; he the said agent first pay  
all costs of the arrest and detention of the said fugitive. — you  
whish this shall be your sufficient Warrant.
