Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay, William Ferguson

be accounted for.

His Excellency the Governor this day selected Juliana Berston
of Frederick County, a deaf & dumb girl reported by the Levy Court
of said County, under the act providing for the Education of pindigent deaf
and dumb, to be sent to the Pennsylvania Institution to be Educated
at the expense of the State.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Howard
Kennedy Administrator of Thomas Kennedy, or order, six dollars for
publishing two advertisements, and a Proclamation, by order of the
Executive, amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Claude
and A. Hammond or order seven dollars & six pence, for Stationary
for the Adjutant General, amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay
Ladimir Duval or order one dollar & twelve cents for Stationary
Army of amount allowed.

The following Command was made upon His Excellency the
Governor of the State of New Jersey for the person therein named as a
fugitive from Justice, upon application and the information and
evidence therein mentioned being filed in the Executive Department.

To His Excellency David Eckley Governor of the State
of New Jersey. Whereby a certain Negro Man named Emory, son
of William Houghle H. H. H. of Talbot County in this State, stands
charged by depositions of John C. Robinson and Robert R. Ross of Talbot
County, aforesaid, with Stealing and other crimes and offenses against the
peace Government and dignity of the State of Maryland. And that
information has been received at the Executive Department, that
that the said Negro Man Emory have as aforesaid.
