

His Excellency the Governor, this day, granted a Pardon to Samuel Tomlinson on account of Felony of which he had been convicted in Allegany County Court at October Term 1832, and for which he had been sentenced to the Penitentiary for five years. (See Pardon Record)

Saturday March 8 1834

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James O. Barker or order six dollars fifty cents for publishing two proclamations in the year 1832 &c. accounted all owed.
