Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland, have appointed you my agent to receive  
from the Honble William Branch chief Justice of the Circuit Court of the District  
of Columbia, a certain Matthew Albob, a fugitive from the Justice of this State,  
and I do hereby authorize and direct you upon receiving the said fugitive,  
to bring him into this State and convey and deliver him to the Sheriff of Patuxent  
Arundel County to receive for having stolen a Horse from Joseph Isaac.

Given under my hand and the Great Seal of the State of Maryland,  
this seventeenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and thirty four, and of the Independence of the  
United States the fifty eighth.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George F  
Brewer or order thirty dollars for making returns to the Commissioners of the  
Taxes of the several Counties of Lands ready for patent since the last return  
as allowed by Law.

Friday March 21st 1834

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John  
A. Audubon or order one hundred and fifty dollars on account of  
Books purchased of him for the State Library, Certificate of the Librarian  
under Resolution of the General Assembly.

Tuesday April 1st 1834

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James  
Thomas or order one hundred and sixty six dollars sixty six cents for one  
quarter salary as Governor due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas  
Culbreth or order three hundred and seventy five dollars for one quarter  
Salary as Clerk of the Council due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas  
McNeary or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one  
quarter Salary as a member of the Council due this day.
