

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jeremiah Hughes or order three thousand five hundred and forty dollars twenty five cents viz. for sixteen hundred copies of the Laws of the last Session \$1234 of Contract for sixteen hundred copies of the Journal of the House of Delegates \$2166 of Contract for boxes and packing the Journals & Laws \$41.25; for advertising a meeting of the Executive \$1.00; and for publishing sundry Lists of the last Session, by direction of the Clerk of the Council in virtue of an Order of the House of Delegates \$68 of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Clerk of the Council give notice in the Maryland Republican that proposals will be received by the Executive for building of new House, and repairing the out Houses and Wall around the circle.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William McNeir or order twelve hundred dollars for sixteen hundred copies of the Journals of the Senate of Contract with the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Gideon White & William Brewer or order twelve dollars for taking an Inventory and appraising the Furniture in the Government House of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George S. Fanchard, William Kirby, John N. Conroy, Samuel R. Turner, Edward Coppage and John A. Kopper Commissioners for removing obstructions in Chester River or to them or order one thousand dollars in virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John V. Murphy or order five hundred and twenty nine dollars twenty five cents for balance due him for re-building and repair of State Tobacco Warehouse No. 2, in virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G. Stick or order seventy four dollars seventy five cents viz. for cleaning Muskets under Resolution of the General Assembly \$73.50 and for Sawing Arms \$1.25, of amount allowed.
