And whereas information has been received at the Executive Department of this State that the said James Dean, alias Peter James Dean, of the County of Frederick in the State of Ohio, charged with the offence aforesaid, upon the oath of one John D. Keedy of Washington County aforesaid, a rebel being important and highly necessary for the good of society, that the perpetrators of such offences should be brought to justice. - Now, therefore, I James Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, do hereby demand the said James Dean, alias Peter James Dean, as a fugitive from the Justice of this State, and make known to your Excellency that I have appointed Henry Thompson, the Sergeant of the Executive Council, my agent to receive the said fugitive and bring him to this State, having Jurisdiction of the said offence, that he may be brought to trial thereon.

In compliance with the requisitions of the Law, I herewith annex and produce to your Excellency a Copy of the evidence upon which this demand is founded, which I certify is authentic.

The State of Maryland, To Henry Thompson, Sergeant of the Executive Council, greeting; Be it known that proposing great trust and confidence in your prudence and honesty, I James Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland, have appointed you my agent to receive from His Excellency the Governor of the State of Ohio, James Dean, alias Peter James Dean, late of Washington County, a fugitive from the Justice of this State, and I do hereby authorize and direct you, upon receiving the said fugitive, to bring him into this State, and convey and deliver him to the Sheriff of Washington County, to answer for having killed Jacob Kline of the said County.
