Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas W. Neazy or order two hundred and fifty dollars, for six months salary as a member of the Council, due the first Instant.

Ordered Saturday July 19th 1834.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Joint committee of the State Library or to their order one hundred dollars for defraying expenses of the construction of the new Library, by Resolution of the General Assembly and certificate of the said Committee.

Wednesday July 23rd 1834.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Joint committee of the State Library or to their order four hundred dollars for defraying expenses of the construction of the new Library, by Resolution of the General Assembly and certificate of said committee.

Monday July 28th 1834.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Mills or order thirty dollars, for six months Rent of Magazine, due the 3rd of May last.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Franklin or order thirty five dollars, for one year Rent of Guard House, due the first Instant.

Saturday August 2nd 1834.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Elizabeth Simmons or order six dollars and seventy five cents for one quarters salary for cleaning the public temple, due the first Instant.
