Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John Sullivan or order one dollar for hanging a window in the Clerks office of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Samuel Mays or order two hundred and fifty dollars for six months salary as a member of the Council, due the first ultimo.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Richard P Bayly or order eighty dollars for publishing in his paper sundry acts of Assembly, by direction of the Clerk of the Council, in virtue of an order of the House of Delegates, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington Tuck or order three hundred and seventy one dollar fifty cents viz \$347:62 1/2 for cleaning and repair of arms, under Resolution of the General Assembly, \$12:50 for removing guns, boxes & 62 1/2 cents for hauling empty boxes, \$1:50 for going out to the powder House, \$8:50 for firing Salutes on the 4th of July and 75 cents for putting a lock on the magazine, of amount allowed.
