

trial of the prosecutions lately instituted in the Baltimore Criminal Court, and now removed to the Maryland County Court for trial, and any other Criminal prosecutions now pending, or which may hereafter arise either in the City of Baltimore or any other County in this State, growing out of the disclosures which have been or may hereafter be made in relation to the failure of the Bank of Maryland or any other monied institution in the City of Baltimore - and

Be it further Resolved that the Attorney General be and he is hereby authorized, if in his opinion it shall be necessary for the cause of Justice to draw upon the Treasurer of the Western Shore for any sum of money not exceeding two hundred and fifty dollars, to be paid out of the fund known and distinguished on the Books of the Treasurer as the contingent fund, to enable him to transport, or cause to be transported to the State of trial of said prosecutions, such books and papers as may be necessary, and to reimburse such disbursements, on the part of the State, as may be made to defray their own expenses. And the Attorney General is further required to state a full and accurate account of any disbursements he may make under this Resolution, and cause the same to be laid before the County Court of the County chargeable with the costs of said prosecution, to be paid as said such charges are paid in that State the same may be returned to the Treasurer of the State of Maryland and paid to the contingent fund - where deposited.
