Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay (Price) J. Goldborough, Paymaster of the Extra Battalion of the Militia in Dorchester County, or order three hundred and twenty seven dollars fourteen cents for pay and Rations due to the Artillery company commanded by Captain J. Donovan, and the Infantry Company commanded by Captain J. Spedden for service in the year 1830 as adjusted by the Governor and Council, of payroll furnished said Paymaster.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Benjamin Hughes or order one hundred and sixty six dollars fifty cents viz: \$150 for delivering Laws and Journals to the Clerks of the several Counties & Resolutions of the General Assembly, \$3 for Printing Certificates for Laws, \$3 for Publishing Proclamations of Congressional Election, 50 cents for Carrying United States Laws, \$1 for Publishing notice of a meeting of the Executive, and \$9 for Printing for the Executive of an amount allowed.
