

Saturday August 9th 1834.

His Excellency granted a Pardon to John H. Sullivan, on account of an assault & battery on Stephen Robinson, which was charged against him by the return in and out of Arundel County Court.

Sunday August 12th 1834

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Miles or order fifteen dollars for one quarter's rent of Magazine due the 3rd Instant.

Wednesday August 27th 1834

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Benjamin Brown and Philip Atchison & Sons of Williams Brown & Co or to their order one hundred and fifteen dollars nineteen cents for balance due to the said Williams Brown for his services as Examiner General, after deducting the amount of fees received from the first of April, this date, to the 3rd day of June last of amount proved.

Wednesday September 3rd 1834.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Green or order two hundred and thirty eight dollars ten cents for postage due him since the 1st day of July, viz for the Executive, \$38.37 for the Assistant General, \$191.79, for the Librarian, \$3.84 and for the Treasurer \$4.90, & account proved.

Notice having been given for the Council to meet this day His Excellency the Governor, and the Honble Samuel Chase and George W. Washington members of the Council attended.

Saturday September 6th 1834

His Excellency the Governor granted the following Pardon and Pardon Prosequis viz

To Samuel Kaine on account of a beating of which he was convicted in Baltimore City Court in February Term 1833, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for two years.
