I do, therefore, I James Thomas, Governor of the State of Maryland by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, do hereby demand the said Daniel Hoose alias Jurgens, as a fugitive from the Justice of this State, and make known to your Excellency that I have appointed the said Frederick Storv my agent to receive the said fugitive and bring him to this State, having Jurisdiction of the said offense, that he may be brought to trial therefor.

In compliance with the requisition of the Law, I do with annex and produce to your Excellency a copy of the warrant upon which this demand is founded, which I certify is authentic.

The following commission and instruction was issued to the aforesaid agent, viz

To the State of Maryland I Frederick Storv gentleman, greeting. Do hereby know that reposing great trust and confidence in your prudence and honesty, James Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland, have appointed you my agent to receive from the Governor of the State of Pennsylvania Daniel Hoose alias Jurgens, a fugitive from the Justice of this State, and I do hereby authorize and direct you, upon receiving the said fugitive to bring him into this State, and convey and deliver him to the Sheriff of Washington County to answer for having under a false pretence and with a felonious intent obtained from your possession a valuable horse and feloniously carried away said horse.
