

of Massachusetts, it appearing from authentic documents transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, that the said William Duval stands charged by the affidavit of John Lemist with having feloniously stolen, taken and carried away from the City of Boston in the said State, Bank Bills and Silver Coin of the Value of twenty three thousand dollars, of the Goods and Chattels of the Norfolk Bank, at Roxbury. Now, therefore, I James Thomas, Governor of the State of Maryland, do hereby require and enjoin all persons within this State, to let the said James Peice, agent as aforesaid, pass with the said fugitive unobscured to the said State of Massachusetts, let the said agent conducting himself in a peaceable and orderly manner, and using no improper severity or cruelty in his treatment of the said prisoner.

The following demand was made upon His Excellency George Wolf Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, for the person therein named as a fugitive from Justice, upon application, and the information and evidence therein mentioned being filed in this Department. Viz

To His Excellency George Wolf Governor of the State of Pennsylvania. Whereas a certain John Browley stands charged by the affidavit of Columbus P Durham, with having stolen a quantity of Jewels from Canfield & Brothers of the City of Baltimore, in this State. And whereas information has been received at the Executive Department of this State, that the said John Browley has fled from Justice, and is now in the State of Pennsylvania. And it being important and highly necessary for the good of Society that the perpetrators of such offences should be brought to Justice. — Now, therefore, I James Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, do hereby demand the said John Browley, as a fugitive from the Justice of this State, and make known to your Excellency that I have appointed Mr George Riggs, my agent to receive the said fugitive, and bring him to this State, having Jurisdiction of the said offence that he may be brought to trial therefor.
