

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, and by and with the advice and consent of the Council, the following civil appointments were made and commissions issued, accordingly, viz.

Alexander H Laffoon additional Justice of the peace of Washington County. ✓

Peter Hoffman, on the board of Managers for removing people of Colour vice Sheppard resigned. ✓

James F Brown Register of Wills of Hunt County, vice Wilson deceased. ✓

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Johnson or order eight dollars for cleaning out the State House Cellar &c amount allowed. ✓

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Hamer or order ninety and dollars five cents for balance of his salary as Examined General from the 1st of August last to the first instant, after deducting the amount of fees received, &c amount proved. ✓

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G Cook or order two hundred and ninety seven dollars twenty five cents for cleaning and repair of stoves, under Resolution of the General Assembly, &c amount allowed. ✓

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William D Bell or order sixty eight dollars for publishing in his paper sundry Laws by direction of the Clerk of the Council, in virtue of an order of the House of Delegates, &c amount allowed. ✓

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Pardon to Levin Leatherbury free Negro on account of stealing in two several cases, of which he had been convicted in Somerset County Court at November Term 1831, and for which he had been sentenced to the Penitentiary for two years, in each case.
